PARKING LOT

As you arrive at Whitford Country Club, please use caution in the parking lot. If desired, you may drop off your golf bag at the bag drop or at the porte-cochere (side entrance of Clubhouse). Whitford is a full-service club and the changing of shoes or clothes in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. Please come inside to the locker room to change shoes or clothing.

PROPER ATTIRE

All Whitford members and guest are expected to be dressed in appropriate attire, depending on the activity and venue.

GOLF COURSE:

- Denim is not permitted.
- Collared shirts are required for men and must be tucked in at all times.
- Hats are to be worn forward at all times. Men are asked to remove their hat at all times inside the clubhouse.
- Cargo shorts/pants, gym shorts, sweat pants, and T-shirts are also not permitted.
- Women are kindly asked to wear traditional golf attire. Such as tailored pants or skirts, capris, Bermuda shorts, golf shorts/skirts, skorts, sundresses, blouses, sleeveless tops, and non-collared or collared shirts.
- Women are asked to refrain from wearing T-back tops, cut offs, halter tops, running shorts, T-shirts with stenciling, tank and tube tops, workout/warmup/running/yoga pants/suits and denim of any kind.

CLUBHOUSE:

Whitford's clubhouse has an upper and lower level:

- Upper level – Appropriate upper-level attire is considered: (Male) Dress pants or Bermuda shorts and a fold down collared shirt or mock collared shirt that maintains a minimum of a one-inch collar. (Female) Dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts or dresses and business casual tops are permitted. No jeans of any type or color are permitted on the upper level unless waived for a special event. Jackets and/or ties are not required.
- Lower level & the Patio– Appropriate lower level/patio attire is considered the same as above except that jeans in good taste and racquet and golf attire are permitted. Men are asked to remove their hats at all times inside the clubhouse, including in the locker room.

PLEASE REMEMBER...

- No T-shirts (sports logoed T-shirts), jerseys or graffiti shirts of any type are permitted at the Club.
- Children are expected to follow the dress code as well.

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Whitford's membership takes great pride in our golf course and our staff works very hard to keep it in top condition. Please do your part in helping to keep it that way by remembering the following:

- Whitford is a soft spike facility. The use of metal spikes is prohibited.
- Please fix your own ball mark on the green. Look for at least one extra you can fix.
- Replace all divots. If you are unable to replace the divot with its original turf, please fill the divot with sand & seed available in bottles on golf carts.
- Golf cart traffic should follow all signage and be kept away from tee boxes and greens. If there is a cart path, it is expected that you use it and all four wheels should remain on the path at all times.
- Please play "ready golf" and keep up with the group ahead of you. It is expected that an 18-hole round of golf will be completed in 4 hours or less.

CELL PHONE USAGE

Cell phone use is permitted for sending text messages and checking email as long as there is no disruption to other members. Members are asked to leave dining facilities and other high traffic areas to use cellular phones for voice calls. Please keep all phones on silent/vibrate while on club property.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted indoors anywhere on campus, including the locker rooms and bathrooms. Smoking is not permitted around any outdoor dining areas, during meal service times.
